JOSHUA	JOSHUA	1406–1380 BC	Israelites victoriously entering and conquering the promised land	God gives Israel victory as they trust and obey Him	God is faithful to His promises and fights for His people
JUDGES	SAMUEL	1380–1051 BC	Israelites in cycles of sin, oppression, and deliverance needing leadership	God disciplines His people but raises deliverers when they repent	Sin leads to judgment; repentance brings God's merciful deliverance
RUTH	SAMUEL	1160–1100 BC	Israelites during dark days of judges needing hope and redemption	Loyal love and God's providence in ordinary life events	Obedience and faithfulness bring God's blessing and redemption
1 SAMUEL	SAMUEL, NATHAN, GAD	1105–1011 BC	Israel transitioning from judges to monarchy under Saul and David	God establishes kingship in Israel through Saul; David's anointing	Obedience to God is better than sacrifice; choose God's way
2 SAMUEL	NATHAN, GAD	1011–971 BC	Unified Israel under David's reign, witnessing triumphs and failures	David's kingdom expands; his sin with Bathsheba has lasting consequences	Even great leaders sin; God disciplines but remains faithful
1 KINGS	UNKNOWN	971–853 BC	Israel during Solomon's glory and the tragic division into two kingdoms	Solomon's wisdom gives way to folly; kingdom divides over sin	Compromise and idolatry destroy unity and bring God's judgment
2 KINGS	UNKNOWN	853–586 BC	Divided kingdoms of Israel and Judah spiraling toward exile	Both kingdoms fall into exile due to persistent disobedience and idolatry	Continued rebellion against God results in judgment and exile
1 CHRONICLES	EZRA	CREATION–971 BC	Postexilic Jews needing to remember David's reign and God's promises	David's reign emphasizing temple worship, priesthood, and covenant	God's promises to David's line point to the future Messiah
2 CHRONICLES	EZRA	971–538 BC	Postexilic Jews learning from Judah's history of faithfulness and failure	Faithfulness to God brings blessing; idolatry brings judgment and exile	Worship God faithfully and He will bless
EZRA	EZRA	538–456 BC	Jewish exiles returning to rebuild temple and renew covenant	God keeps promises, enabling temple rebuilding and spiritual reformation	God's faithfulness brings restoration; spiritual renewal requires obedience

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NEHEMIAH	NEHEMIAH	445–425 BC	Returned exiles rebuilding Jerusalem's walls and renewing covenant	Nehemiah leads Jerusalem wall reconstruction despite opposition	Godly leadership and determination accomplish God's purposes
ESTHER	UNKNOWN	483–473 BC	Jews scattered throughout the Persian Empire facing genocide threat	God's hidden sovereignty protects His people from destruction	God works providentially even when circumstances seem hopeless
JOB	UNKNOWN	2100–1900 BC	Suffering believers questioning God's justice and sovereignty in trials	Righteous suffering, God's sovereignty, and the mystery of divine justice	Trust God's wisdom even when circumstances make no sense
PSALMS	DAVID, MULTIPLE	1410–450 BC	God's people expressing the full range of emotions in worship and prayer	Praise, lament, thanksgiving, and worship directed to God	Express honest emotions in praise to God; He hears and responds
PROVERBS	SOLOMON, MULTIPLE	950–700 BC	All seeking wisdom for practical, righteous living in daily life	Practical wisdom for godly living; fear of the Lord brings knowledge	Wisdom begins with fearing God; apply His principles to life
ECCLESIASTES	SOLOMON	935 BC	People seeking meaning and purpose in life's seeming futility	Life without God is meaningless; fear God and keep His commandments	Ultimate meaning is found only in fearing God, not worldly pursuits
SONG OF SONGS	SOLOMON	965 BC	Married couples and those preparing for marriage covenant	Celebration of romantic love, intimacy, and marital faithfulness	Marital love reflects God's love; celebrate covenant relationship
ISAIAH	ISAIAH	739–681 BC	Judah facing judgment but needing hope in coming Messiah	Judgment for sin, comfort for the faithful, messianic prophecies	God judges sin but offers salvation through the Suffering Servant
JEREMIAH	JEREMIAH	627–586 BC	Judah ignoring warnings of judgment and impending Babylonian exile	Warning of judgment, call to repentance, promise of a new covenant	God's judgment is certain, but restoration follows for the faithful
LAMENTATIONS	JEREMIAH	586 BC	Survivors grieving Jerusalem's destruction and Babylonian captivity	Poetic mourning over Jerusalem's fall; God's faithfulness endures	Even in deepest sorrow, God's mercies are new every morning
EZEKIEL	EZEKIEL	593–571 BC	Jewish exiles in Babylon needing hope for restoration and renewal	God's glory departs but will return; Israel will be restored	God's presence leaves due to sin but returns with restoration
DANIEL	DANIEL	605–536 BC	Exiled Jews serving in pagan courts, needing faithfulness and hope	God's sovereignty over kingdoms; faithfulness in exile brings deliverance	Remain faithful to God in hostile culture; His kingdom prevails
HOSEA	HOSEA	755–715 BC	Northern Israel committing spiritual adultery through idolatry	God's faithful love despite Israel's spiritual adultery and unfaithfulness	God's love remains despite our unfaithfulness; return to Him
JOEL	JOEL	835–805 BC	Judah after devastating locust plague, facing greater judgment ahead	Locust plague foreshadows the day of the Lord; call to repentance	Repent before judgment; God pours out His Spirit on all people
AMOS	AMOS	760–750 BC	Prosperous but unjust Northern Israel ignoring the poor and oppressed	Social justice; God judges nations for oppression and injustice	God demands justice and righteousness, not empty rituals
OBADIAH	OBADIAH	848–841 BC	Edom gloating over the invasion of Jerusalem; Judah needing vindication	God judges Edom for pride and violence against Judah	Pride brings destruction; God defends His people against enemies
JONAH	JONAH	785–750 BC	Israel learning God's compassion extends beyond its nation	God's mercy extends to all who repent, even Israel's enemies	God shows mercy to all who repent; do not limit His compassion
MICAH	MICAH	735–710 BC	Israel and Judah facing judgment for injustice and false worship	Judgment on injustice; prophecy of Messiah's birth in Bethlehem	Do justice, love kindness, walk humbly with your God
NAHUM	NAHUM	663–612 BC	Judah oppressed by Nineveh, needing assurance of God's justice	God's judgment on Nineveh for cruelty; God avenges His people	God is slow to anger but will not leave the guilty unpunished
HABAKKUK	HABAKKUK	610–605 BC	Believers troubled by God using wicked Babylon to judge Judah	Questioning God's justice; the righteous live by faith	Trust God's wisdom even when His ways seem hard to understand
ZEPHANIAH	ZEPHANIAH	640–610 BC	Judah in spiritual decline, needing warning before coming judgment	Day of the Lord brings judgment but also restoration and joy	Judgment is coming; seek the Lord with humility and righteousness

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HAGGAI	HAGGAI	520 BC	Returned exiles neglecting temple rebuilding for personal comfort	Prioritize God's house over personal comfort; obedience brings blessing	Put God's priorities first; He will bless your faithfulness
ZECHARIAH	ZECHARIAH	520–518 BC	Returned exiles rebuilding temple needing encouragement and hope	Visions of coming Messiah and restored Jerusalem under God's reign	God will establish His kingdom through the coming Messiah
MALACHI	MALACHI	432–425 BC	Postexilic Jews becoming spiritually apathetic with insincere worship	Rebuke for corrupt worship, improper offerings, and broken promises	Honor God with sincere worship and faithfulness before His coming
MATTHEW	MATTHEW	4 BC–AD 30	Jewish readers questioning if Jesus is Israel's promised Messiah	Jesus is the Jewish Messiah fulfilling Old Testament prophecies	Jesus is King; recognize Him as the fulfillment of God's promises
MARK	JOHN MARK	AD 26–30	Roman Christians needing fast-paced account of Jesus' powerful ministry	Jesus is the Suffering Servant with authority over all creation	Jesus came to serve and give His life as a ransom
LUKE	LUKE	4 BC–AD 30	Gentile readers needing detailed, orderly account of Jesus' life	Jesus is the compassionate Savior of all people	Jesus came to seek and save the lost; salvation is for everyone
JOHN	JOHN	AD 26–30	Believers and seekers needing to understand Jesus' divine nature	Jesus is the divine Son of God offering eternal life	Believe in Jesus as God's Son and receive eternal life
ACTS	LUKE	AD 30–63	Early Christians spreading the gospel from Jerusalem to Rome	Holy Spirit empowers the church to spread the gospel	God's Spirit enables His people to be witnesses everywhere
ROMANS	PAUL	AD 57	Roman Christians needing systematic explanation of salvation	All sinned; justification comes through faith in Christ alone	Salvation is by grace through faith, not human works
1 CORINTHIANS	PAUL	AD 55	The Corinthian church divided by immorality, factions, and ignorance	Unity, purity, and proper use of spiritual gifts in church	Love must govern all Christian conduct and spiritual gifts
2 CORINTHIANS	PAUL	AD 56	Corinthians questioning Paul's authority and ministry credentials	Paul defends his apostolic ministry and calls for reconciliation	True ministry shows God's power through human weakness
GALATIANS	PAUL	AD 49	Galatian churches influenced by false teachers adding the Law to the gospel	Justification is by faith alone, not by works of the Law	Find freedom in Christ; don't return to bondage of legalism
EPHESIANS	PAUL	AD 60–62	Ephesian Christians needing to understand their identity in Christ	Church's unity in Christ and believers' spiritual blessings	Walk worthy of your calling; maintain unity in the Spirit
PHILIPPIANS	PAUL	AD 60–62	Philippian church needing encouragement amid trials	Joy and contentment in Christ regardless of circumstances	Rejoice in the Lord always; find contentment in Christ
COLOSSIANS	PAUL	AD 60–62	Colossian believers facing false teaching about Christ's sufficiency	Christ's supremacy and sufficiency over all things and powers	Christ is supreme; you are complete in Him alone
1 THESSALONIANS	PAUL	AD 51	Young church confused about Christ's return and deceased believers	Encouragement in persecution; hope in Christ's second coming	Live holy lives while eagerly awaiting Christ's return
2 THESSALONIANS	PAUL	AD 51–52	Thessalonians misunderstanding timing of Christ's return, some idle	Clarification about the day of the Lord; exhortation to diligent work	Don't be idle; work diligently while awaiting Christ's return
1 TIMOTHY	PAUL	AD 62–64	Timothy leading the Ephesian church, needing ministry guidance	Instructions for church leadership, sound doctrine, and proper conduct	Guard sound doctrine; lead the church with integrity
2 TIMOTHY	PAUL	AD 66–67	Timothy facing persecution, needing encouragement to remain faithful	Endure hardship; guard the gospel; pass on sound teaching	Be faithful to the end; guard the gospel entrusted to you
TITUS	PAUL	AD 62–64	Titus organizing Cretan churches needing sound doctrine and leaders	Qualifications for church leaders; sound doctrine produces godly living	Teach sound doctrine that produces good works and godliness
PHILEMON	PAUL	AD 60–62	Philemon receiving back runaway slave Onesimus, now a believer	Christian reconciliation and forgiveness transcend social status	Forgive others as Christ has forgiven you

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HEBREWS	UNKNOWN	AD 64–69	Jewish Christians tempted to return to Judaism under persecution	Christ's supremacy over the old covenant; faith must persevere	Jesus is superior to all; hold fast your faith
JAMES	JAMES	AD 45–50	Jewish Christians scattered abroad needing practical faith guidance	Genuine faith produces good works and practical obedience	Faith without works is dead; live out your faith
1 PETER	PETER	AD 63–64	Christians suffering persecution in Asia Minor needing hope and strength	Suffering for Christ brings glory; stand firm in true grace	Rejoice in suffering; it proves faith and brings glory to God
2 PETER	PETER	AD 66–67	Christians facing false teachers and needing to grow in knowledge	Grow in grace and knowledge; beware of false teachers	Grow in Christ; false teaching leads to destruction
1 JOHN	JOHN	AD 90–95	Christians needing assurance and discernment regarding truth and love	Assurance of salvation through love, obedience, and right belief	Know you have eternal life; love one another genuinely
2 JOHN	JOHN	AD 90–95	Church warned against showing hospitality to false teachers	Walk in truth and love; reject false teachers	Don't support false teaching; walk in love and truth
3 JOHN	JOHN	AD 90–95	Gaius commended for hospitality; Diotrephes rebuked for pride	Support faithful teachers; don't imitate evil but good	Show hospitality to faithful workers; follow what is good
